 - * Distributing supplies to participants and ensuring all equipment is operated safely. Retrieving supplies once participants have completed the project.
 - * Properly securing the trailer and all its contents.
 - * Making sure trailer is clean and free of all debris upon return.
 - * Ensuring proper parking of the trailer in the project area.
 - * Replacement of any missing items or items not returned in the condition they were received (normal wear and tear excluded).
 - * Make sure all gasoline cans are empty before placing them back in the trailer.
 - * Completion of a **Cleanup Summary Form**.
